

NoCA – North Cambridge Arts Application

Background: NoCA is an all-volunteer organization, composed of artists living and/or working primarily around North Cambridge, sustained solely through member dues. The group began in 1997. In 2008, we marked our eleventh Open Studio year and represented 60+ artists. The Open Studios event, as of 2009, is now being run through the Cambridge Arts Council, and it has a separate registration fee.

NoCA exists to provide collegial support among artists of all disciplines and to facilitate links with the local community. We have regular meetings where we share artwork and often have a potluck dinner. NoCA also has a Winter Gathering in November where members can show and sell their work in a group setting.

We accept visual artists, writers, poets, playwrights, musicians, dancers - all the arts.

Attendance at monthly meetings is not mandatory, but encouraged.

Registration: Registration for new and returning members is on a calendar-year basis and is open throughout the year. Dues are good for the calendar year in which you join.
